



Instructions for Jails and Prisons on Implementing Chromebooks Reaching Only DefenseMap.com

Chromebooks are an excellent resource for implementing [DefenseMap.com](https://www.defensemap.com) in these secure settings. Following are simple steps to prepare Chromebooks for inmates' use in accessing only [DefenseMap.com](https://www.defensemap.com) and blocking access to any other sites or communication tools.

The following steps must be completed for each Chromebook, but they take only a few minutes.

1. Contact us through our [Helpline](#). We can answer any questions and walk you through these steps. We need to be on the phone with you in Step 9 to provide you the code necessary to comply with the multi-factor authentication. Once on the phone with us, you can open the Chromebook.
2. If prompted about activating ChromeVox, click **No**. (This feature is for automatic out-loud reading of all pages and is a terrible distraction for inmates.)
3. Connect to your Wi-Fi.
4. If prompted, choose your language and proceed (you may see a "Get started" or similar button).
5. If prompted, accept the Google Terms of Service.
6. When asked about who is using this Chromebook, choose "You/Adult" (this may be pre-selected). Then, don't click "Next," but instead at the bottom of the page click "Enterprise enrollment."
7. On the next page, enter the email: charlie@freedom22.org
8. On the next page, enter the password: SJCJDefenseMaps
9. Enter the security code that we provide you and click Next.
10. Click "Done" and proceed with the arrows. The secure [DefenseMap.com](https://www.defensemap.com) will now load and be ready for inmates' use with no access to any other sites or communication tools.
